

## **The Facts About Community Choice Aggregation**

- Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) allows cities to replace the local electric company as the provider of electric power—without a vote of the people.
- Once the CCA program is implemented, all customers within the area will be *automatically* enrolled if they do not opt out.
- Under the CCA program, customers could be charged unspecified “exit fees” if they do not opt-out at the right time.
- According to the San Francisco Controller’s Economic Impact Report, “...the final customer bill [could] be 24% higher under CCA...”
- San Francisco’s budget analyst estimates startup costs of \$8 – \$12 million, and ongoing administrative costs of roughly \$10 million annually.
- The San Francisco Board of Supervisors has the power to issue billions of dollars in revenue bonds to finance new renewable generation capacity without a vote of the people.
